

OUTRAGES IN ARMENIA.

Report That England Is in Consultation with
Other Powers.

VIENNA, Dec. 10, 1894. It is asserted here that the government of Great Britain has taken the initiative in the matter of obtaining an interchange of views with the powers in regard to the outrages in Armenia. Further diplomatic action in connection with the Armenian situation has been suspended in the meantime.

The Sultan of Turkey has been informed of the action of England, and has called a council of his ministers, expecting the powers to intervene.
