

## BISHOP OF MOOSH ARRESTED.

LONDON, Dec. 14, 1894. The Odessa correspondent of the Times says: "A telegram says that Turkey has arrested the Bishop of Moosh and members of the church council, because they reported the Turkish massacres to the British vice-consul. Hundreds of Armenians are emigrating to Russia. It is stated that Mgr. Khrimlan, the Catholicos, already has appealed to the Czar, who also gave an audience to the archbishop of Georgia."

The Daily News correspondent in Constantinople writes: "Complaints have reached Constantinople that in many districts of Asia Minor Armenians are imprisoned for ransom. It is reported that the head of every Armenian family in Bitlis has been in prison. Bitlis is the city of eastern Turkey where the massacre of Armenians first occurred. Its population consists of 25,000 Kurds, Armenians and Turks."
